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Who We Are

Piedmont Columbus Regional's Midtown Campus is the flagship hospital of Piedmont Columbus Regional, and the largest in west Georgia and east Alabama. The Midtown Campus is a 583-bed, acute care hospital providing a comprehensive array of healthcare services to meet the medical needs of the diverse region we serve.



The Bill and Olivia Amos Children's Hospital is the area's Children's Miracle Network Hospital, and only children's hospital within Piedmont. A dedicated, pediatric-trained care team paired with a child-friendly, therapeutic environment allows parents to take comfort in knowing their child is receiving quality care.

Midtown Campus has been home to the Family Medicine Residency Program since 1972. The nationally recognized program, which was the first of its kind in Georgia and one of the first in the Southeast, has graduated over 1,000 family physicians.

A significant renovation and expansion is taking place to increase critical care capacity; it will include 43 new ICU beds and a renovated 15-bed nursing unit. Construction is tentatively set to be completed in March 2026.
